

Technical Arts Coordinator Full-Time (40 hrs/week)



Role Overview

The Technical Arts Coordinator supports the Creative Arts Team by utilizing professional production technology (for Audio, Visual, and Lighting) to support weekend services, events and ministry activity at Christ The Rock.

Qualifications

- AV degree or equivalent work experience required
- Experience with a professional level of production technology, with a specialty in audio and lighting
- Excellent understanding of the following AVL equipment:
 - Audio – Allen and Heath dLive 7000, SLS CPA line array, Biamp system processing, Waves Soundgrid processing/Dante routing
 - Video – Hitachi DLP Laser Projectors, Panasonic Video Switchers, Blackmagic routing
 - Lighting – ETC Nomad/Eos Programming Wing
- Ability to work with a Team
- Good communication skills
- Ability to recruit and train volunteers
- Character of a Christ Follower

Responsibilities

- Recruit willing and talented volunteers to ensure all aspects of the Technical Arts Team are staffed with creative and reliable people for the ministry's immediate needs.
- Evaluate the abilities of volunteers and train and equip to enhance technical skills of all persons involved in the Technical Arts Team.
- Encourage the technical and spiritual development of all persons participating in the Technical Arts Team.
- Manage volunteers for the technical production of Weekend Services as well as church wide events.
- Train volunteers of all levels to be proficient operators of professional level production technology, with a specialty in digital audio and lighting.
- Oversee all Technical (AVL) elements for weekend services and building wide events.
- Oversee the maintenance, care and use of all AVL production equipment campus wide.
- Assure that all areas related to "production", such as sound booth, storage closets, tech balcony and FOH are clean, neat and properly organized.
- Willingness to enhance personal production skills through additional training and resources.

Availability: 40 hours per week. Some evening and weekend hours will be required. Must participate in weekly planning and production of weekend service meetings and all staff meetings and development. Must meet with an assigned Coach.
